Sporting clay ranges are established with different shooting scenarios configured to simulate hunting type settings. The typical sporting clay range consists of various shooting stations laid out in a circuit or configured around multi-station towers.

In the vast majority of instances, the pellets from these target loads will travel no more than about 725 feet when shot from the optimum muzzle elevation. To be safe, the NRA and other clay target associations recommend establishing a shot fall buffer zone of 900 feet from the point where the gun is fired.

Sector Rules for Reopen - Connecticut

Sections 243 and 1010 of the 2010 Standards require an accessible turning space for each different type of firing position at a shooting facility if designed and constructed on a site. Where firing positions are provided in clusters, five percent (5%), but at least one position of each type in each cluster must be accessible.

Most of the class was taught at a straight lane outdoor range where students fired at paper targets, with earth backing behind the targets. Students spread out approximately 4 feet apart in a line about 15 yards away from the targets. During live fire exercises, instructors stood about 2-3 feet behind students.
